Tap water instead of bottled water



You save/conserve:



- Tap water instead of bottled water
 Drink water from the tap. It costs a lot
 less than the water you buy from the
 supermarket. That way, you can save
 €300 per person per year.
- A bottle or a mug have one with you all the time!

Take a drinking bottle from home when you are on the road. Instead of buying mineral water, you can fill your bottle with water at drinking fountains and taps. You can also use your own coffee mug when buying a coffee-to-go. The production of plastic bottles alone consumes about



Save money and energy while cooking





You save/conserve:



Use a lid

Always cover the pot with its lid when you cook. An open pot needs more energy and will cost more money!

Use the right pot size If the pot is larger than the hotplate, cooking time will take longer. If the pot is smaller than the hotplate, the unused heat is energy wasted.

Use energy sparingly

Take as little water as possible so it boils faster. Turn off the electric cooker before the food is completely cooked. Cooking will be done while the hotplate is still warm.


Turn off the tap

Save money, water and energy! Simply turn off the water when you are lathering your hands, brushing your teeth or lathering yourself up in the shower.



- Put out the light when leaving the room
 - Always turn off the light when you leave the room!
- Remove chargers from the socket Smartphone, tablet and laptop chargers still use up power even when the device is fully charged, or even when no device is attached. Unplug the charger when it's not being used.
- Switch off electrical appliances completely

Electrical appliances (televisions, game consoles, etc.) consume electricity also in stand-by mode. With switchable multi-socket outlets, you can switch off the devices completely.

Ventilate properly



 Ventilate with the window fully open instead of tilting it to the side

Do not leave windows tilted open in the cold season when heating is required. Instead, open them completely for a few minutes. This way, you prevent a lot of heat from escaping and reduce the risk of molds building up on the walls. Turn down the heating while ventilating.

Save money while washing your laundry



You save/conserve:




You can save a lot of energy and money while washing and drying clothes if you follow these three tips:


- Always fill the washing machine completely
 - Less laundry in the washing drum means more frequent washing and therefore more energy consumption.
- Wash at low temperature settings
 Heating the water consumes the
 largest amount of energy during
 washing. For normally soiled laundry
 a 40°C temperature setting is enough,
 for heavily soiled laundry 60°C is
 sufficient
- Hang laundry to dry on the clothesline instead of in the dryer In the springtime until autumn, you should hang your laundry on a drying rack or on a clothesline.



Save money when shopping, and reduce waste too



You save/conserve:



- Have a bag, rucksack or basket with you to replace the disposable bags you get at the checkout counter.
 Disposable bags cost money when you buy them and they are bad for the environment.
- Always have a reusable net bag ready for loose fruits and vegetables to avoid using disposable plastic bags from the supermarket.

Save paper

Put a sticker on your mailbox that says "No advertisements please." In Germany alone, 2.7 million trees and 4.62 billion liters of water are used to produce free mailbox advertising.

Use recycled paper

Buy only toilet paper, kitchen rolls, printer paper, exercise notebooks, tissues, etc. made from recycled paper. Around 60 percent of energy and water as well as wood are saved in the production of recycled paper compared to what is needed to produce virgin fiber paper. Recycled paper can be identified by, for example, the "Blue Angel" symbol.
